

CHRISTIAN CENTER SCHOOL DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR

General Guidelines

- These guidelines are intended to reflect a simple, appropriate, school professional standard of dress in keeping with the local area.
- Parents should ensure that their children comply with the dress requirements during all school activities.
- Clothing must be clean, in good repair, and have the right fit.
- Hoodies, hats, or hair should not cover students' faces and must be removed upon request.
- *All Junior High and High School students should have professional apparel for presentations.*
- No make-up allowed until grades 7-12.
- Students should have no visible tattoos.
- Earring piercings are allowed.
- Girls may have one small nostril piercing, no other facial piercings are allowed, including septums.
- All clothing is subject to teacher approval.

Everyday Dress Code

Pants:

- Most styles are acceptable, except for pajama-type pants and leggings.
- Distressed jeans must not have holes or tears showing skin above the knee cap.
- Distressing above the knee must be patched or a layer worn underneath
- Leggings can only be worn as a secondary layer under shorts, dresses, or skirts.

Shorts:

6th - 12th Grade:

- Modest in length, no shorter than 5 inch inseam (a standard length found in stores) for all shorts, including athletic shorts. Parents, please ensure this length is adhered to as it is uncomfortable for staff to measure shorts.

Preschool-5th Grade

- Midthigh

Shirts:

- No t-shirts resembling an undershirt as outerwear.
- No thin or see-through materials.
- No tank tops or camisoles without another sleeved shirt layered over top.
- No secular band logos, occult symbols, or objectionable branding.
- Midriff should be covered at all times, even with hands fully raised.

- No cutouts allowed.

Shoes:

- Dress or athletic shoes in good repair.
- Sandals or flip-flops allowed for 4th grade and above during warm months.
- Grades K through 3 should wear shoes with ties or Velcro year-round.
- PE requires appropriate athletic shoes.

Girls:

- Dress or skirts should be a minimum length at the knee cap, unless opaque leggings are worn underneath (tights or stockings are not opaque leggings).
- Grades PreK - 6th, please layer shorts under skirts/dresses
- Modest necklines that cover cleavage.

Boys

- Appropriate and modest fit of pants and shorts

P.E. Dress Code (Grades 1 through 12):

- P.E. CCS T-shirts required, available for purchase online.
- Shorts should meet the minimum length requirement of 5 inch inseam.
- Warm-up pants and sweatshirts allowed.

1st-6th Grade:

- P.E. T-shirt with school logo and athletic shoes.
- Gym shorts (no compression shorts, minimum length as mentioned above).
- Optional shorts available for purchase online.

7th-12th Grade:

- Uniform gym shorts required in gray, black or navy. Gym shorts can be ordered from Standout Promotions or purchased from store of choice.
- CCS T-shirt required.
- Athletic shoes.
- Sweatshirts and warm-up pants/joggers are allowed.

**Coaches may set different requirements for after-school athletic practices and games.*
